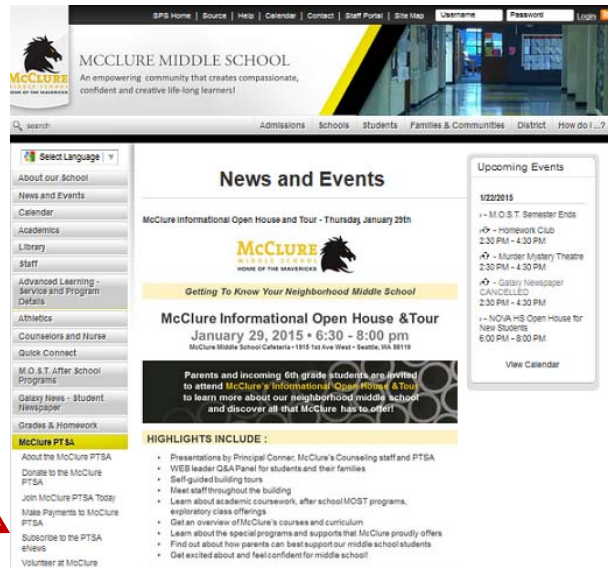
There are many ways to stay informed about what is happening at McClure

Subscribe to the PTSA's weekly eNews:

The McClure PTSA works with the administration and staff to publish a weekly electronic newsletter. Subscribing to the e-newsletter is the best way to find out what is happening at school, upcoming activities, school and PTSA announcements, volunteer opportunities, SPS news and community happenings for middle school students. **The PTSA does not get parent email addresses from the school so parents (and students) need to sign up online or by using this link.** <http://goo.gl/wPY5Jq>

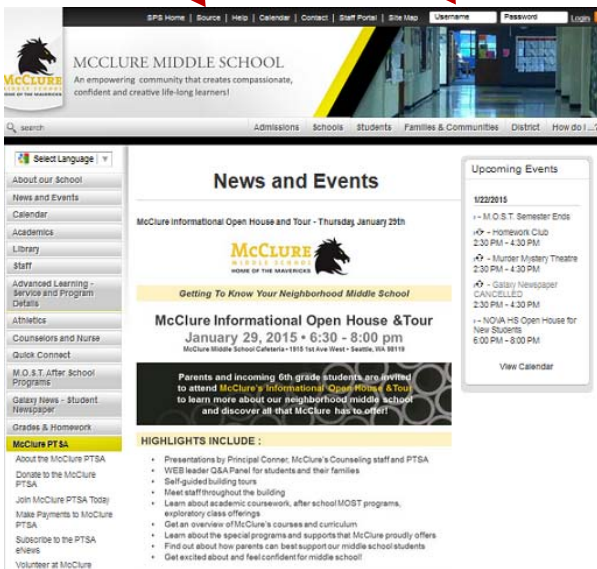
We encourage all parents and students with email addresses to stay in touch with us this way. Normally we publish once a week, but there are times when we also send "stand alone" emails with mid-week news, important reminders, the Principal's newsletter etc.

Seattle Public Schools hosts and maintains the website and the PTSA helps to update the school Calendar, News and Events page and other pages on the website.

During the school year, the **McClure Fusion page** is the source of information about your child's schedule, classes, assignments and classroom news. To access Fusion pages, go to the McClure website and log on at the top right. Choose "My Family" from the left hand menu to view your child's classes, recent activity and links to class pages. You can set your email notification preferences at the "My Account" link as well, so posts and assignments from teachers push to your email.

Powerschool (formerly known/ also known as **The Source**, <https://ps.seattleschools.org/public/>) is the page where you access your child's schedule, grades, attendance, test results, library records etc. That is a separate logon screen from the Fusion pages, and is accessible by clicking The Source at the top right of McClure's website.
