You should also write a mini-review for each book read.

You will be handing your reading record and mini-review in to your ELA teacher in the first week of school.

Students are encouraged to **create an account on typingweb.com** (or use their typingagent.com account) and practice typing three times a week. Students will receive a typing test in the library the first month of school which may determine placement in a keyboarding club at lunch.

Students are also encouraged to use newsela.com to read at least six nonfiction or magazine articles over the summer.

Use Overdrive.com to download free e-books and audiobooks from the public library.
