First Round/Applications & Recommendations:

- Tuesday, April 25th: Applications are due to Ms. McGinty's box in the Main Office by 4:00 pm
- Wednesday, April 26th: Teachers are asked to make recommendations; students receive notification of receipt of application

Second Round/ASB Campaign:

- Thursday, April 27th: Students notified via email if they will/will not participate in the ASB campaign
- Friday, April 28th: Students notified at school and will meet with ASB advisor during 6th period
- Monday, May 1st – 5th : Students campaign for office in accordance with campaign regulations
- Friday, May 5th: Elections – votes are tallied at end of day

Elected ASB Leaders:

- Friday, May 5th: Students notified via email if they have been elected as an officer
- Monday, May 8th: Results of ASB Officers' election for 2017-2018 announced at McClure
- Monday, June 12th: Mandatory meeting with new ASB Leaders from 3:30-4pm in Room 207

ASB EXPECTATIONS

Below is a list of meetings and activities that ASB officers will be expected to do as leaders of the McClure student body. Please read the expectations to determine your level of interest and commitment.

- Leadership Training on Monday, August 28th, 2017 from 9 a.m. to 12:00 (**mandatory**)
- New Student Orientation (for new 7th and 8th graders) on August 31st, 2017 from 8 a.m. to 12:30 (**mandatory**)
- First day of school: Arrive at 8:15am, or when your bus arrives, to assist incoming students
- Plans and participates in school events throughout the school year* (may require time outside of school, as announced)
- Attend regular officer meetings
- Lead large and small groups using communication and collaboration skills
- Fulfill officer requirements in accordance to position description
- Maintains a GPA of 3.0 or higher for the duration of the school year with no grade lower than a C
- Acts as a role model for McClure students and ASB representatives
- Completes community service hours every quarter
- To enroll in ASB as a class, you will need a **PE wavier** if you have another full-year elective like Spanish, Band or Orchestra

***Note: Some of these activities require missing school time. If selected, you will be required to make up all work. We expect that you will meet with your teachers before class time is missed and communicate how you will make up what you missed. If you miss a test or a quiz you will need to reschedule a time with your teacher.**
