First Round/Applications & Recommendations:

- Tuesday, April 25th: Applications are due to Ms. Draggoo's mailbox in the Main Office by 4:00 p.m. Students will receive a confirmation receipt during 6th period the day after submission.
- Wednesday, April 26th: Teachers are asked to make recommendations for WEB Leader applicants

Second Round/WEB Tryouts:

- Thursday, April 27th: Students notified via email if they will/will not participate in WEB Tryouts
- Friday, April 28th: WEB Tryout Packets handed out during 5th period in brief meeting with Ms. Draggoo. Round 2 candidates will receive instructions for this meeting in their Thursday night email

WEB EXPECTATIONS:

Below you will see a list of meetings and activities you will be expected to do as a McClure Middle School WEB Leader. Please read the expectations below to determine your level of interest and commitment:

- **Mandatory** Leadership Training on Monday, August 28th from 9 a.m. to 12:30pm
- **Mandatory** New Student Orientation on Thursday, August 31st from 8 a.m. to 12:30pm
- First day of school: Arrive at 8:15am or when your bus arrives to assist 6th graders
- Lead WEB Events, help with school tours, plan and coordinate special projects, participate in class discussions, and complete all coursework*
- Complete 15 community service hours outside of class every quarter
- Act as a role model for others in and out of the classroom
- Maintains a GPA of 3.0 or higher with no grade lower than a C.
- To enroll in WEB as a class, you will need a **PE wavier** if you have another full-year elective, like Spanish, Band or Orchestra
